PASTORAL TEACHINGS, DIRECTIVES, NOTES & SAYINGS

Dear in Christ, faithful of the St. Vincent Family
Glory to Jesus Christ!

Our goal in coming to the Divine Liturgy and bringing our children along is to engage them and us as much as possible.

Sometimes we get distracted, and certainly this is understandable, but the more we can engage the more meaningful the Liturgy will be for all of us.

Of course, it's important for us to be quiet as we enter the temple, prepare for the Divine Services, and begin our worship. However, it's also important to try to keep ourselves and our children engaged in the various parts of the Liturgy, particularly in what are often called *the high points* such as **the 'Offering'** "*thine own of thine...*", and **the 'Epiclesis'** "*and make this bread the body of your Christ...*".

I have asked Presvytera Linda and Rachel Huebert to teach some of the children the meanings of the 'Offering' and the 'Epiclesis' in an age-appropriate way when they are downstairs during the homily.

Furthermore, as a refresher for the adults on this subject, there will be a 3 - 4 minutes teaching immediately before the announcements, beginning sometime in the middle of September.

Prayers and blessings as we enter the beginning of the Ecclesiastical (Church) New Year!
